



Happiness & curiosity

In 1998, Karl Locher, owner of Brauerei Locher AG, asked himself how it could be possible to get to the aromas and beer extracts of former beer casks. Almost by coincidence, he had just stumbled across some 60 to over 120 year-old beer casks used by his ancestors whilst carrying out a rebuild project. Karl Locher, who is now the fifth generation owner of the family business, knew that from 1999 onwards, a law from the Second World War was to be changed. The said law had previously forbidden the Swiss to burn barley, a staple food product

Thanks to that one light-bulb moment, he has brought the hard work and investments of his ancestors back to life and enabled us to produce a unique whisky that is highly awarded all across the world.

Success & what happened next

Säntis Malt quickly made a name for itself, much quicker than expected. And that also meant the 26 Appenzell mountain inn hosts were eager to share the Säntis Malt with their guests. Whilst most were content with that, the interest of one Appenzell host was piqued to try something even more special. Sepp Manser, host at Berggasthaus Meglisalp had done his research and found that more and more special editions of Säntis Malt Whisky were coming onto the market. This prompted him to ask if he could also have a special edition of the whisky, exclusive to his inn. Brauerei Locher AG has always been open to new ideas. So in sum mer 2012, Berggasthaus Meglisalp was able to serve guests its very own, exclusive whisky. A pretty good idea that delivered beyond expectation!

Enjoy the journey

Inspired by the huge demand for the whisky at Meglisalp Brauerei Locher AG and host, Sepp Manser put their heads together and thought about how they could take the success story at Berggasthaus Meglisalp and roll it out across the area - ma king it an attraction throughout the Appenzeller Bergwirteverein mountain inn host association. In the Appenzell, it's always been «all for one and one for all», and so the idea of the Whisky Trek was born.

Something different in every cask

Each and every one of the 26 whiskies on the trek is unique. There are differences not only in terms of aromas, but also in terms of color, with the range spanning from a light, straw color to deep gold. And that's despite them all starting off with the same in gredient: malted barley spirit from the Appenzeller Brauerei Locher. So how do so many variations of the whisky develop? This is down to numerous factors which influence the maturation process, including temperature, moisture level and height above sea level. The higher a cask matures, the more liquid evaporates and consequently, the stronger the concentration. There is a 1700 meter difference between the height above sea level at the Brau quöll in Appenzell and the Berggasthaus Alter Säntis. That means that with every meter, the whisky gets stronger. The temperature at which the cask is stored is decisive when it comes to length of maturation: The lower the temperature, the longer it takes.

And last but not least, the casks are responsible for those extra nuances. Exclusive wooden casks from all over the world previously held Port wine, sherry, rum, Pinot Noir or even plum schnaps. Even years later, the casks pass these flavors onto the whisky which develops both a unique color and flavor. That means that every cask, and each and every bottle has a distinctive character.



Hikers should be able to correctly judge conditions and potential dangers in the mountains. Sure-footedness is absolutely essential. Exposed routes should only be accessed if you have a good head for heights.
